On Wednesday the 31st of May 2006 the members of the GVP team of Malawi visited the Katsekaminga Community Day Secondary School in the Dedza district. Team leader Pius Mvenya Junior accompanied his young colleagues. The aim of the project is to educate students about basic information on HIV/AIDS and human rights. Messages concerning these issues are the core of the Malawi GVP team's project work.



At Katsekaminga School they organized dramas, poems, songs, traditional dances and also a reggae and rager music festival. More than 250 students and 20 teachers attended. In his speech the headmaster encouraged the students to continue spreading the message on social behavior change. He called for support of the victims of either human rights abuse or HIV/AIDS.
