They tried to give an understanding to young Malawians for the problems by means of music, traditional dances and the performance of dramas.

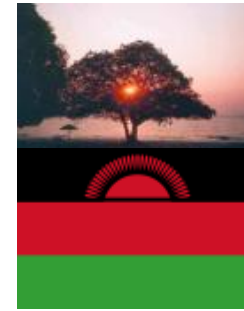

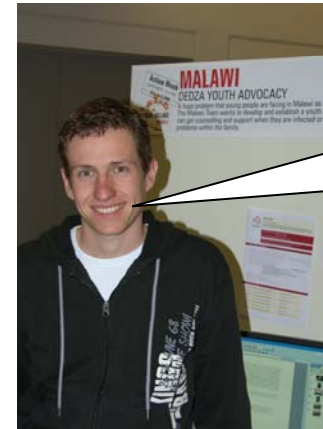
For Friday a visit to the Dedza Christian Primary School and Dedza RC School is on the agenda.
