PROMOTING AGRICULTURE AND FOOD SECURITY: THE CONSTRUCTION OF A VEGETABLE GARDEN AT ST. EDWARDS SCHOOL

Day One

Five students, **George, Mamadu, Sorie, Abdul and Ali** went to a market called **Big Market** in Freetown to buy the plants and seeds for their garden project: **Krain Krain** (green leaves people in Sierra Leone use to cook sauce), **Sour Sour** (a similar vegetable), **corn, garden eggs and red peppers**.



Furthermore the boys bought **20 packets of fertilizer** and **five packets of nails** for the fence of their garden. All together they spend **4.000 Leones** which is about 1,35 US Dollar.





Day Two

Together with **Paul and Michael from Peace Child** the boys went to **Congo Town Warf**, a market nearby the school, to buy sticks for their garden fence. For constructing it the guys hired a **carpenter** for **4.000 Leones**. Including the charge for the transport the fence cost **12.000 Leones**, about **4 US-Dollar...**
